Bamboo Industrial Cuts are supplied by the Forest Department to the Paper Mills in Andhra Pradesh based on the Selling Price fixed by the Government as per the procedure prescribed in A.P. Forest Produce (Fixation of Selling Price) Act, 1989 and Rules, 1991.

2. In the G.O. 1st read above, M/s APITCO Ltd., Hyderabad have been appointed for taking up the consultancy to prepare proposal for fixation of Selling Price of Bamboo Industrial Cuts to be supplied to the Paper Mills in Andhra Pradesh for the lease year 2005-2006 as per the proposal of Prl.Chief Conservator of Forests, Hyderabad.

3. In the reference 2nd read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has reported that M/s APITCO Ltd., Hyderabad has recommended a selling price of Rs.1495/- per M.T. which is higher than the present production cost price of Rs.531/- per M.T. and more than the last year is selling price of Rs.1453/- per M.T. The recommended price of Rs. 1495/- per M.T. is (Rupees one thousand four hundred ninety five per Metric Tone) inclusive of moisture loss and exclusive of extraction, transportation costs and applicable taxes.

Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests duly taking into consideration, the recommendations of M/s APITCO Ltd., Hyderabad, hereby accord permission to conduct sales at a Price of Rs. 1495/- per Metric Ton (inclusive of moisture loss) for the lease year 2005-2006 for supply of the Bamboo Industrial cuts to the Paper Mills in Andhra Pradesh.
